- 11. Consideration concerning Senate Bill 100 Uniform elections, Council reviewed OPTION A, OPTION B, OPTION C AND OPTION D, which summarizes the options for complying with the new law. Councilwoman Cottrell moved that the city adopt OPTION D, to change the elections to odd number years only, and eliminate the staggered terms, so that the entire Council is elected in May of each odd year. The motion was seconded by Councilman Myers. The motion was approved with 4 Ayes and 1 No. Councilwoman Mudd voted No. The city attorney will submit a resolution at the next city council meeting to act on.
- 12. Consideration to approve proposed accounting services agreement for auditing services, Council tabled for another proposal.
- 13. City Secretary distributed Brazoria County letter to re-enter Brazoria County after a disaster to the Mayor and Council.
