None being absent, constituting a quorum at which time the following business was transacted.

SPECIAL MEETING

- 1. Mayor Michael Holton called meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 3. Consider authorizing actions and expenditures to prepare for, respond to, and deal with flooding and related condition, Councilwoman Cottrell moved to authorize mayor to Expend funds Motion was seconded by Councilwoman Smajstrla. Approved unanimously.
- 4. Consider consent to extension of declaration of disaster beyond seven days, in order to authorize extended curfew order and all other disaster powers of the Mayor,
- A. Approval of an ordinance to supplement to the Emergency Management Plan: Councilman Byrum-Bratsen moved to approve the Ordinance to supplement the Emergency Management Plan as written. Seconded by Councilman Wilsey. Approved with 3 Ayes, 1 Nayes and 1 Abstained. Councilwoman Smajstrla voted no. Councilwoman Bradbery abstained.

- B Extension of Disaster Declaration, Councilwoman Cottrell moved to extend the declaration. Seconded by Councilwoman Smajstrla. Approved unanimously.
 - C. Curfew: No action on curfew.
- 5. Being no further business, Councilwoman Cottrell moved to adjourn. Seconded by Councilman Byrum-Bratsen. Motion was approved unanimously.
