- 1. Mayor Holton called meeting to order at 7:26 P.M.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 3. Citizens Comments: Timothy Underwood, resident of Meridiana, spoke in favor of Crime District to give the Police Department another tool of funds.

- 4. Discussed formation of Iowa Colony Crime Control and Prevention District.
- 5. Council convened in Executive session at 7:42 p.m. under Texas Government Code section 551.074 to deliberate concerning appointment of Temporary Directors of Iowa Colony Crime Control and Prevention District. Returned to open session at 8:02 p.m.
- 6. Consider approving an ordinance proposing the creation of Iowa Colony Crime Control and Prevention District and appointing Temporary Board Members of that District. Councilman Byrum-Bratsen moved to adopt an ordinance proposing the creation of the Crime Control and Prevention District.
