

Signs That Do Not Require Sign Permit

Stake Sign – Sign supported by a structure that is pointed for easy placement and removal.

Ex.) Real Estate, Contractor Services, and Event Signs.

- Stake Signs DO NOT require a permit.
- Maximum effective area – 9 square feet.
- Maximum height – 4 feet.
- Maximum of 2 stake signs on non-residential zone or use property.
- Stake signs cannot be located on SH 288 frontage.
- Needs to be removed 3 days after the event
- Cannot be in the street ROW

Window and Door Signs - Sign affixed to or mounted behind the interior surface of a window or door or directly behind a window pane.

- Size cannot be more than 25% of the total window and door area of the location wall.
- No maximum number – limited by maximum area.

Banner/Balloon Signs (Residential use site)

- Size for In-Use buildings – no higher than the roofline or parapet walls.
- Size for Vacant Buildings – Maximum Height of 10 feet.

Flag Poles (Residential Use Site) – Flagpole means a freestanding pole with an attached lanyard that is permanently affixed to the ground or building and is designed for display of 1 or more flags.

Flag Signs – Flexible fabric material, usually rectangle, that is specifically designed for display by attaching it to the lanyard of a flagpole.

- Flag Size for Non-Residential Use – 60 Square Feet
- Flag Size for Residential Use – 40 Square Feet
- Flagpole Maximum Height for Non-Residential Zone 50 Feet
- Flagpole Maximum Height for Residential Zone 25 Feet
- Maximum of 1 flag per pole in residential zone
- Maximum of 2 flags per pole in non-residential zone

Personal Property Activity Signs

Ex.) “No Hunting”, “No Trespassing”, “Posted”, “For Sale by Owner”, etc.

- No maximum number of allowed signs on private property tract
