

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IOWA COLONY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR TO CALCULATE VARIOUS TAX RATES UNDER THE DISASTER PROVISIONS OF SECTION 26.04(C-1) OF THE TEXAS TAX CODE; AND PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, SEVERANCE CLAUSE, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IOWA COLONY, TEXAS:

1. The City Council of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas ("the City") hereby finds that the City has been subject to a disaster declaration by the Governor of Texas during part of the year 2020, and that the City is eligible to adopt the tax calculation methods provided by Section 26.04(c-1) of the Texas Tax Code.
2. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the Tax Assessor/Collector of the City to calculate the voter approval tax rate in the manner provided for a special taxing unit, under the disaster provisions of Texas Tax Code section 26.04(c-1).
3. This ordinance does not adopt a tax rate.
4. If any part of this ordinance, of whatever size, is ever declared invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
