ORDINANCE NO. 2020-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IOWA COLONY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR TO CALCULATE VARIOUS TAX RATES UNDER THE DISASTER PROVISIONS OF SECTION 26.04(C-1) OF THE TEXAS TAX CODE; AND PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, SEVERANCE CLAUSE, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IOWA COLONY, TEXAS:

- 1. The City Council of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas ("the City") hereby finds that the City has been subject to a disaster declaration by the Governor of Texas during part of the year 2020, and that the City is eligible to adopt the tax calculation methods provided by Section 26.04(c-1) of the Texas Tax Code.
- 2. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the Tax Assessor/Collector of the City to calculate the voter approval tax rate in the manner provided for a special taxing unit, under the disaster provisions of Texas Tax Code section 26.04(c-1).
- 3. This ordinance does not adopt a tax rate.
- 4. If any part of this ordinance, of whatever size, is ever declared invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
