ORDINANCE NO. 2020-27

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IOWA COLONY, TEXAS, FINDING FACTS, ORDERING THE CITY SECRETARY TO MAIL COPIES OF THE PROPOSED HOME RULE CHARTER TO THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IOWA COLONY, TEXAS:

- 1. The City Council finds that the following facts are true:
 - a. The City Council has appointed a Home Rule Charter Commission for the City of Iowa Colony in compliance with Texas Local Government Code section 9.002(d)(1).
 - b. The Charter Commission has prepared a proposed Home Rule Charter of the City of Iowa Colony, Texas in compliance with Chapter 9 of the Texas Local Government Code.
 - c. The City Council has called an election on the adoption of that Charter, in compliance with all applicable law.
 - d. Subsection 9.003(b) of the Texas Local Government Code provides for the City Council to order the City Secretary to mail a copy of the proposed Charter to each registered vote of the City.
- 2. Accordingly, the City Council hereby orders the City Secretary to mail a copy of the proposed Charter to each registered voter of the municipality on or before Friday, October 2, 2020, the 31st day before the charter election, pursuant to subsection 9.003(b) of the Texas Local Government Code.
- 3. If any part of this ordinance, of whatever size, is ever declared invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
