In an effort to mitigate the risks associated with COVID-19 and adhere to the State, County, and Local efforts to allow responsible social gatherings, the following procedures will be temporarily adhered to in relation to mobile food vendors within the City of Iowa Colony.

- I. **Hours of Operation** - Mobile food vendors will only be allowed to operate between the hours of 10:00 AM - 8:00 PM.
- II. **Permits Required** – Proof of an inspection within the last 12 months from the Brazoria County Health Department is required. An on-site fire and life safety inspection by the City of Iowa Colony is required prior to beginning operation of each reservation. The Brazoria County Health Department can be reached at 979-864-1600. The City of Iowa Colony can be reached at 281-369-2471.
- III. **Social Distancing** - Mobile food vendors must have a written pre-established plan for complying with State, County, and Local rules regarding social distancing. Mobile food vendors should use any method available to reduce the chance of persons coming in contact with one another. Methods such as on-line, telephone, text messaging, e-mail ordering, or the use of plexiglass dividers should be considered.

All patrons should maintain 6 feet of separation.

It is also required that vendors wear protective gloves and face masks while service the public. Patrons are encouraged to wear face masks.

- IV. **Enforcement and Penalty** - Any peace officer in the City of Iowa Colony may enforce this order. Violation of this order may include revocation of right to conduct business under this order and/or, pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 418.173, may result in a fine not to exceed \$1,000 or confinement in jail for up to 180 days. This order supersedes any previous order relating to mobile food vendors.
